8th August - Election announcement for AGM

The Trust will post the formal election calling notice on the website. This will include:

- Side policy publication
- Board Member role descriptions and nomination form, 8 elected positions available.
- Applications for Secretary Role – all applications go to the chairman. The Secretary is not an elected or voting position. steve.white@leedsunitedtrust.com
- Board member role applications to be submitted to the Election Management group – elections@leedsunitedtrust.com

19th August – Nominations for Board Member and Applications for Secretary roles close.

Nominations submitted will be counted and if the number of Nominations exceeds the available open board positions a ballot will take place at AGM on 8th September.

21st August – Ballot

We will announce on this date whether a ballot is needed. A ballot paper will be shared if this is the case. Candidate details will then be published on the Trust website with individual statements and pictures.

All Members are notified of the election and will be directed to candidate profiles. Voting will take place in person at the AGM (8th September) or proxy votes can be submitted via email to the Election address. To do this please request a ballot paper by emailing elections@leedsunitedtrust.com

A ballot form will then be emailed to you and needs then to be returned to elections@leedsunitedtrust.com

6th September – Cut-off date for proxy votes by email

8th September – AGM

Voting takes place in person and the proxy votes will be added to the votes counted. No member will be allowed to vote twice. Should there have be no ballot due to the number of nominations either being the same as, or less than, the number of vacancies then the Board Appointments will be ratified by an official vote by those attending. If there is a ballot, then those elected will be either be announced to the AGM or the day after via website/social media.
